Missouri has many assets for companies looking to relocate, such as a business climate that encourages growth, competitive incentives, a large, highly skilled workforce, exceptional transportation infrastructure, and some of the lowest business costs of any state. These are just a few of the many reasons why so many successful businesses have already chosen to locate here.

Missouri is central and connected for more efficient access to major markets.

- Missouri's central location provides efficient access to both coasts. Missouri is within 600 miles of 50% of U.S. households, 52% of U.S. manufacturing establishments, and six of the fastest growing major metros in the U.S.: San Antonio, Austin, Chicago, Atlanta, Dallas, and Houston.
- The population center of the U.S. is located in Texas County, Missouri (Census Bureau).
- Missouri is bordered by eight states, tied with Tennessee for the most of any U.S. state.

A low-cost, pro-business environment helps companies prosper.

- Missouri is one of only seven states to receive the highest bond rating by all three rating agen- cies.
 Fitch Ratings, Standard & Poors and Moody's Investor Service all gave Missouri the highest bond rating in 2012.
- Missouri is ninth in the "Top 10 Pro-Business States," according to Pollina Corporate Real Estate.
- Missouri is in the top 10 of the U.S. for the best business energy costs overall (Small Business and Entrepreneurship Council), regulatory environment (Forbes), unemployment insurance tax rate (Tax Foundation), and property tax rate index (Tax Foundation).

Missouri's extensive transportation system is a dependable delivery system for goods and services.

- Missouri has some of the best and least congested transportation infrastructure in the United States.
 It has the sixth largest public road and highway system, two of the largest rail terminals in the U.S., the northernmost ice-free ports and the southernmost lock and dam on the Mississippi River.
- Missouri is just three hours from most U.S. and Canadian cities by air. International service is accessible from Lambert-St. Louis International and Kansas City International.

Missouri has an ample supply of highly educated, low-cost labor.

- Missouri boasts a workforce with a greater level of educational attainment than the national average, in addition to having 138 post-secondary educational institutions, more than most other midwestern states.
- Missouri's labor force exceeds the entire populations of 20 states, including neighboring Kansas, Arkansas, and Nebraska.
- Missouri workers support a wide range of industries in the state with their diverse skill sets, while the average hourly wage is only \$19.47—significantly lower than the national average of \$21.74 (Bureau of Labor Statistics, Occupational Employment and Wage Estimates, May 2011).

Missouri Facts

- Missouri had the 13th lowest average industrial electricity costs in 2012, at 5.85 cents/kWh (EIA).
- Missouri has an excellent regulatory and tax climate for business. In 2012, Missouri's regulatory environment was ranked tenth best in the nation by Forbes. Missouri has the eighth lowest corporate tax index and the sixteenth best tax climate overall in the U.S. (Tax Foundation, 2013).
- Missouri's workforce of over 3 million exceeds the entire populations of 20 other states, including neighboring Kansas, Arkansas and Nebraska (BLS, 2011).
- Missouri earned a AAA bond rating for the past 46 years. Missouri is also one of only seven states to receive the highest rating by all three rating agencies—Fitch Ratings, Standard & Poors and Moody's Investor Service—in 2012.
- 9 Missouri companies were included in 2012's Fortune 500: Express Scripts, Emerson Electric, Monsanto, Reinsurance Group of America, Peabody Energy, Ameren, O'Reilly Automotive, Graybar Electric, and Centene.
- Missouri is also the headquarters for 10 of America's Largest Private Companies, according to Forbes: Enterprise, Graybar Electric, Edward Jones, Apex Oil, World Wide Technology, Bass Pro Shops, Hallmark Cards, Schnuck Markets, McCarthy Holdings, and JE Dunn Construction.
- The 122 hospitals across the state include the top ranked Barnes Jewish Hospital.
- Missouri has the third most diversified economy in the U.S. with a GDP over \$249 billion (BEA) and exports totaling over \$14.2 billion (WiserTRADE).
- Missouri has 106 enhanced enterprise zones located throughout the state.
- Missouri has 138 post-secondary degree-granting institutions, including Washington University in St. Louis, ranked fourteenth best in the United States by U.S. News and World Report.



Transportation & Logistics

Central Location

- Missouri is within 600 miles of 50% of U.S. population and households.
- Missouri is within 600 miles of 52% of total U.S. manufacturing establishments.
- Missouri is within 600 miles of six of the fastest growing major metros: San Antonio, Austin, Nashville, Atlanta, Dallas, and Houston.

Highways and Interstates


- Missouri has the sixth largest public road and highway system in the nation with 33,667 miles (Federal Highway Administration, 2009).
- Major interstates include I-64, I-44, I-70, I-55, I-35, I-29, and I-49.
- I-49, connecting Kansas City and Joplin, was designated an interstate in 2012.
- I-70, which bisects Missouri, is over 2,000 miles long and passes through 10 states. Interstates 29 and 35 are located within the NAFTA corridor, providing easy access to Canada and Mexico.
- Missouri ranked ninth for Federal highway funding in 2011, with \$1.11 billion (State Rankings, Federal Highway Administration, 2010).
- There are more than 110,000 commercial trailers registered in Missouri (Bureau of Transportation Statistics, 2011).

Class 1 Rail System

- Missouri provides efficient, low-cost ship- ping across the country via all Class I carriers:
 Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF), Kansas City Southern (KCS), Norfolk Southern (NS), Union Pacific (UP), CSX, Canadian National Railway (CN), and Canadian Pacific (CP).
- Missouri is ranked in the top ten for U.S. railroad mileage (Association of American Railroads).
- Missouri is ranked fourth in tons and third in rail carloads carried by state (Association of American Railroads).
- Two of the largest U.S. rail terminals are located in Kansas City and St. Louis, linking over 4,000 miles of track throughout the state.








 The 1,340 acre CenterPoint KCS Intermodal center includes a thousand acre industrial park located directly adjacent to the new Kansas City Southern Intermodal Facility. With infrastructure in place, these sites are build-ready for facilities up to one million square feet. KCS will offer direct rail service to CIC-KC from the natural deepwater port of Lazaro Cardenas, Mexico.

Waterways and Ports

- Missouri is ranked tenth for inland waterway mileage (1,000 miles), moving an average of \$4.1 billion in cargo annually.
- Twenty-nine industrial centers, with a combined population of 90 million, can be reached from St. Louis by barge. St. Louis is the northern-most point on the Mississippi river that normally remains ice-free and open throughout the year. The city is also the location of the southernmost lock and dam on the Mississippi (Missouri Port Authorities).
- Missouri has 13 strategically located public port authorities and one regional port commission (Missouri Port Authorities).
- Nearly 4,500 acres are available for development adjacent to Missouri's port authorities.

Airports and FTZs

- Missouri travelers can reach most cities in the United States and Canada in less than three hours by air.
- The airport system in Missouri consists of approximately 130 public airports, with two providing international service: Lambert-St. Louis International and Kansas City International.
- Springfield, Branson, Joplin, Columbia, Cape Girardeau, Kirksville and Waynesville (Fort Leonard Wood) also have commercial service.
- Missouri has foreign trade zones in Kansas City, Saint Louis, and Springfield.
- The FTZ at Lambert-St. Louis International Airport was recently expanded to include all of St. Louis and St. Louis county.
- The KCI Intermodal BusinessCentre includes 8,000 acres of multi-use land for development on the airfield designated FTZ and enhanced enterprise zone.
